# About CareNet?

CareNet provides food relief to people in our community who are experiencing financial hardship.

Our programs include:

- Centre-based food relief program
- The Satellite Pantry Network

## ELIGIBILITY & CONTRIBUTION:

To be eligible for CareNet's centre-based program you need to be:

- experiencing financial hardship.
- living in either Manningham, Banyule or Nillumbik.

CareNet asks for \$5 from each client to assist us to cover our running costs.



## CENTRE BASED PROGRAM

**THURSDAY'S 10AM TO 2PM (EXCLUDING PUBLIC HOLIDAYS)**

### WHEN YOU ARRIVE:

On your first visit, our program host, will ask you to fill out an intake form and provide us with some ID with your address on it. (We will not ask you specific questions about your situation).

You will then be shown how to book in further appointments and shown around the program.

We encourage all our community members to bring their own grocery bags to appointments.

### THE PROGRAM

There are 3 stations within the program

#### 1. THE PRODUCE MARKET

The produce market is stocked with fruits, vegetables and bread with signage to inform you of how much you are welcome to.

#### 2. THE PANTRY ROOM

The pantry room is stocked with non-perishable grocery products including hygiene, cleaning, pet and baby products. You will be given a prepacked hamper and assisted to choose some other items.

#### 3. THE KITCHEN

From the kitchen you will be provided frozen products such as meat and other items when available.
